Lake Street and Mechanic Street Reconstruction Projects

Street reconstruction of Lake St. and Mechanic St. will begin the first week of June. The streets will be completely torn up, water lines replaced and resurfaced. The project will take approximately 3 months. The construction company and the Village DPW will make every effort to accommodate residents getting in and out of driveways.



There will be days when the streets will be closed for all traffic but you will be notified in advance.

If you cannot get in and out of a driveway, you will need to park on an alternate street for a few days.

Garbage will be picked up on Tuesday mornings as usual. If there is a change you will be notified in advance.

Town of Urbana Compost

The Town of Urbana compost, located off Route 54, behind the Town Barn, is open all the time. Any clean brush, leaves or wood can be deposited in designated areas marked by signs. No plastic or trash. The Steuben County Landfill does not accept yard debris. Therefore, the Village garbage company can not accept yard debris or leaves in bags or otherwise. Mulch is available free of charge for anyone living in the Town of Urbana.
