## Homeowner Responsibility for Water Lines

Code Book of the Village: Chapter 118-6

All outside service lines, building and service pipes, outlets and fixtures shall be maintained in good order and repair and protected from frost, leaks and breaks. These must be promptly repaired, if not in good order, to prevent waste of water.

Responsibility for pipes and mains-Villages

Homeowners or occupants are responsible for that portion of the water/sewer pipe that extends from the subject premises to the street which connects to the water or sewer main. They must be laid and repaired at their expense.

Property Maintenance Code has been updated to include screening commercial Waste Disposal Receptacles.

-Water bills will be sent to property OWNER of record.  
Tenants will no longer receive bills.

## GRAPE STREET PARK RULES

THE PARK NEEDS EVERYONE'S HELP TO KEEP THE PARK SAFE AND CLEAN FOR ALL AGE GROUPS WHICH FREQUENT THE PARK.

Surface material is not to be thrown around.

Nothing is to be thrown over the fence.

Play in the park not the neighbor's yards.

Respect other people in the park at all times.

No course or rude language is to be used in the park.

Skate Boards and In Line Skates are to be used in the Skate Board area only.

Skate Boarders and Skaters are expected to wear protective gear.

No property or equipment is to be tampered with or deliberately broken.

Children need adult supervision.

Garbage needs to be picked up before you leave the park.



## Snow Birds

It is unlawful to place paint, motor oil and chemicals in household garbage. Paint and motor oil can be taken to the Steuben County Landfill and disposed of at no charge. For information on disposal of chemicals call the Steuben County of Public Works 664-2460.

- \*Pick up is on Wednesdays.
- \*Have your garbage to the curb the night before.
- \*Recycling pickup is the second Wednesday of the month.

- \*No construction material
- \*No yard waste - Town compost is open daily behind Town of Urbana Highway Garage
