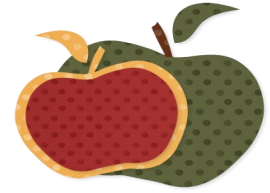

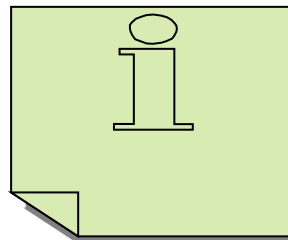
## LAKE STREET RECONSTRUCTION

The Village will begin a street reconstruction project in the early spring of 2014. The project area is Lake Street from Main Street to Water Street. The project will consist of replacing water lines and storm drains along the street as well as resurfacing the road and new curbing. In an effort to keep the public informed, the village board will hold an informational meeting as the project start date draws closer.
