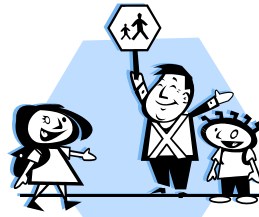

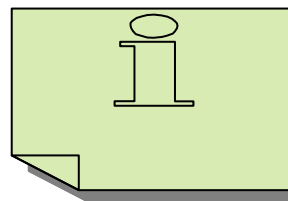
LAKE STREET PICNIC

**Steuben Prevention Coalition
Drug Free Community Survey**

The following questions relate to youth ages 12-18 and will be asked in all 47 communities in Steuben County. Responses will be used to develop strategies and interventions in an effort to bring about community change relating to underage drinking and use of marijuana.

Attention Village Residents: The NYS Department of Transportation is planning to replace Route 54A Bridge over cold Brook in construction season 2015.
