Parking that was prohibited at all times on the south side of Myrtle street within 30 feet of the intersection with Orchard Street has been amended. Parking Prohibited certain hours, on the south side of Myrtle within 30 feet of the intersection with Orchard Street, Monday-Friday from 6:30am to 4:00pm.

New Parking Regulation:
