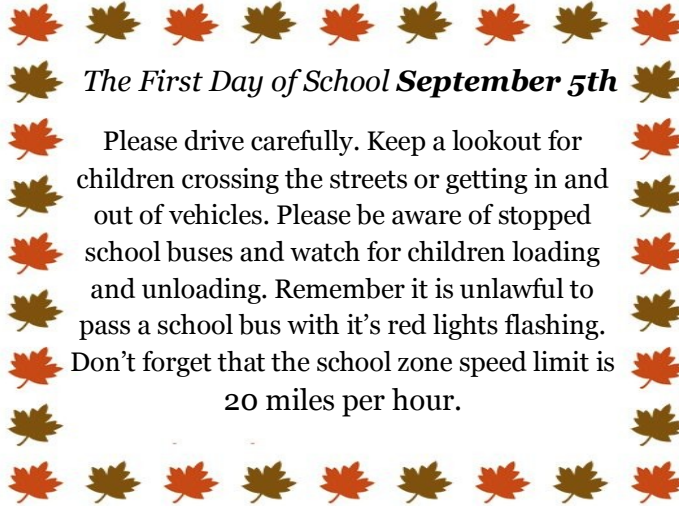

The last day to pay your Village Taxes is **October 31, 2018**.

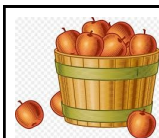
Hydrant Flushing in the Village

Drug Collection Unit



The Hammondsport Police Department has installed a drug collection unit as part of CVS Health’s Medication Disposal for Safer Communities Program. The unit is located inside the Village Clerk’s Office, 18 Water Street, Hammondsport and provides residents with a safe and environmentally responsible way to dispose of unwanted, unused or expired medication, including controlled substances.

Hammondsport’s new Drug Collection Unit Site is open to the public from **9am-4pm Monday thru Friday** and drugs can be dropped off with no questions asked.
