Garbage pick up is **EVERY TUESDAY** of every week.

Recycling pick up is the **THIRD TUESDAY** of every month.



Lawn and Brush Pick Up

1st and 3rd Mondays of the month throughout the summer and fall, **beginning June 7th, 2021.** Leaves, yard waste and lawn clippings **must be in containers** no heavier than 50 pounds.

Tree limbs and brush must be no longer than 5 feet and bundled together with twine. Not complying will result in NO pickup.

** Weekly Garbage hauler does not pick up Leaves, Yard Waste or Lawn Clippings.

Reminder... Seasonal Parking has begun. There is **no parking** June, July and August on Friday, Saturday and Sunday for the following streets:

- Northside of William Street
- Southside of lower Lake Street
- Southside of lower Shethar Street
