Elections will be held on Tuesday, March 21, 2023 from 12:00pm until 9:00pm at the Fred and Harriet Taylor Memorial Library, 21 William Street, Hammondsport.



The following offices will be filled:

**Trustees-** Two (2) positions, two (2) year term each

**Mayor-** One (1) position, two (2) year term each

Newly elected officials will take office April 3, 2023. Prospective candidates for the above offices must be 18 years of age or older, and must have been a resident of the Village for at least 30 days prior to the election.

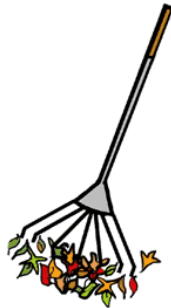

### Drug Collection Unit

The Hammondsport Police Department has a drug collection unit as part of CVS Health's Medication Disposal for Safer Communities Program. The unit is located inside the Village Clerk's Office, 18 Water Street, Hammondsport and provides residents with a safe and environmentally responsible way to dispose of unwanted, unused or expired medication, including controlled substances. **Please, no needles, ointments, lotions or liquids, thermometers, hydrogen peroxide, inhalers or aerosol cans.**



Hammondsport's Drug Collection Unit Site is open to the public from **9am-4pm Monday thru Friday** and drugs can be dropped off with no questions.



According to Village Code, all property owners in the Village are responsible to clear sidewalks of snow and ice **within 24 hours** of the end of snowfall.

Please do not shovel the snow from the sidewalks onto public streets.

Keeping the streets and sidewalks clear during the winter months is important not only for the safety of drivers but for people, young and old, that have to walk to school, the post office, the grocery store, or to get the paper.

**If you are away for the winter months, you are still responsible for the clearing of the sidewalks after the snowfall.**

Please make sure you make arrangements to have someone clear your walks.
